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Submission Requirements

Papers must be original material and not have been previously presented or published. The application of the presented solution is critical for the selection of the paper.

Oral presentations

Will be held within conference sessions addressing key elements of the same topic

Poster presentations

Authors will have the opportunity to present their posters during special poster/dialogue sessions

The synopsis/abstract should be submitted at www.pcim.de as pdf-file and should comprise 2–3 pages. Deadline for submissions: **14 October 2011**

Conditions of acceptance

Authors are expected to secure registration fees of 290 EUR + 19% VAT (190 EUR + 19% VAT for Students/University Staff), travel and accommodation funding through their sponsoring organizations before submitting abstracts.

Selection process

All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Advisory Board to ensure a high-quality conference. Submitted abstracts may be selected for oral or poster presentation. Notification about acceptance is in January 2012. Submission of the full manuscript is due on 12 March 2012.
